Project Overview

Scott County government is facing a serious space deficiency, in the very near future. The County's space shortage is being driven by the need for a future courtroom, a more accessible mental health center, and overall space to serve the county's growing population. This is the right time in the County's history to tackle this issue and develop a long-term, responsible solution.

The County is developing plans to consolidate programs and services; centrally locating them on the main campus, in downtown Shakopee. The project will include a new multipurpose building, new surface parking lot, Government / Justice Center renovations, & a new public works storage building, which will be constructed at the Spring Lake Township Facility.

This winter the County is applying for city zoning permits to allow the new building to match the height of adjacent buildings, allow a variance to place the new building as close to 4th Ave West as the existing building, and finally to vacate some old easements and lot lines running through the center of the main campus block. The City will be notifying surrounding residents and property owners of the public hearing date, time and location for these permits

The construction of the new multipurpose building will improve customer service, enhance the safety and security of visitors and staff, and increase efficiencies across all programs within Scott County.

The proposed renovations of the Government Center and the Justice Center will involve a detailed phasing approach; including minimizing impacts to the neighborhood as well as impacts to daily operations and services involving the public.

The new parking lot will provide the necessary off-street parking for staff and visitors to the main campus.
