Easy 3 Step Process!

STEP 1 Qualify

BUSINESSES AND ORGANIZATIONS QUALIFY AS A VSQG WHEN THEY:

- Generate less than 220 pounds (about 22 gallons) of hazardous waste in a calendar month

STEP 2 Participate

IDENTIFY YOUR WASTES

- Review the product labels
- Look for key words such as “warning,” “flammable,” or “dangerous.”

COMPLETE THE VSQG HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM FORM

- Complete the attached form or;
- Obtain the form online at www.scottcountymn.gov (search for VSQG) or call Richard Jones (rjones@co.scott.mn.us) at (952) 496-8366 or Joan Anderson (jmanderson@co.scott.mn.us) at (952) 496-8477.
- List all wastes and number of containers on the form. Use additional sheets if needed.
- If applicable determine total weights or volumes of each type of waste.
- Only quantity of each type is required for bulbs.
- Find any relevant SDS sheets for the waste.

SCHEDULE YOUR WASTE DROP-OFF APPOINTMENT

- You can make an appointment with us on the website at www.scottcountymn.gov/574/VSQG---Small-Business-Hazardous-Waste-Ma to schedule your own appointment.
- County staff will provide transportation documentation and guidelines if applicable. You will also receive an estimate for the cost of disposal of the waste.
- County staff may contact you after receiving and reviewing the completed form with any additional questions.
- **All businesses that are dropping off wastes that require shipping papers must have or apply for a (EPA) Waste ID number. We can help you apply for a number.**

WASTES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT AN APPOINTMENT.

CHARGES AND PAYMENT

- Fees are based on the quantity and types of wastes (See VSQG Price List).
- Payment is due at the time of drop off in the form of cash, check or credit card

STEP 3 Transport

Read and follow the transportation guidelines provided by Scott County

- Containers must be labeled and in good condition (not rusted or leaking).
- All containers must be 2 ½ gallon size or smaller. Larger containers must be approved in advance by our office.

- At your pre-scheduled appointment time, bring your waste and the completed Transportation Documentation (shipping papers) to (see map):

I understand that 1) fees are subject to change and I agree to pay all fees required of me by Scott County; 2) Scott County reserves the right to charge additional fees if the waste delivered differs from the inventory submitted or if additional analysis or repacking of the wastes is required; 3) Scott County may refuse to accept any wastes that are not pre-registered and approved; 4) completion of this and other forms does not expressly imply that the waste listed on the waste inventory will be accepted; 5) I am required to read and follow the transportation Minnesota Department of Transportation (MNDOT) guidelines provided to me; 6) Scott County is not responsible for damage, accidents or spills that occur as a result of transporting the waste; and 7) I am responsible for the safe and legal transportation of waste to the collection site.
