

## **SCOTT COUNTY ORDINANCE 32**

### **POSSESSION OF CATALYTIC CONVERTERS**

#### *AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE POSSESSION OF CATALYTIC CONVERTERS*

#### **1.0 TITLE**

This ordinance shall be known, cited, and referred to as the Scott County Possession of Catalytic Converters Ordinance and shall be referred to herein as the Ordinance.

#### **2.0 POSSESSION OF CATALYTIC CONVERTERS**

No person shall be in possession of a catalytic converter that is not attached to a motor vehicle unless the individual can provide verification of legal receipt of the catalytic converter or proof of compliance with the requirements in Minnesota Statutes, Section 325E.2 I, Subd. I b.

#### **3.0 VIOLATIONS.**

The violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, the violator shall be subject to fine or imprisonment or both, as set forth in Minnesota Statutes, plus in either case, the costs of prosecution.

4.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance becomes effective on the date of its publication, or upon the publication of a summary of the ordinance.
